Winterizing the Pool: "First Come First Served"

It is always best to keep your pool open for as long as possible to reduce the growth of algae. Algae will not grow in water colder than 58 degrees. Turn off all heaters a few weeks prior to closing your pool. Keeping a strong dark cover over the pool for the winter will reduce sunlight and allow chemicals to stay in the pool water longer. (For more information on safety covers contact us) Recommended times for closing here in Middle Tennessee (depending on the warmth of the weather) would be between September 1st and October 31. Beyond by appointment only.

Opening your pool as soon as possible in the spring will reduce the opening chemical costs and give your pool a head start on chemicals and circulation. Don't wait until things start to bloom, that is too late and will cost a lot in chemicals (you don't have to swim in it or even start your season with a professional company but getting it up and running will save you money on chemicals throughout the whole season). Opening your pool should be done from March 7th through April, in a normal year. Remember the sooner the better for you"

Closings: \$550.00 (Material/Chemicals Extra) **NOTE: Have all equipment available for us; we do not call to set up a day or time**

- Vacuum and brush pool down (If need be)
- Clean out filter (empty water if sand filter. Remove filters/elements (DE) to be cleaned and dried) Cleaning filters or DE grids with solution will be an extra charge. Simply hosing filters out is part of normal closing procedure. *(Keep in mind the filters and grids should be professionally cleaned on a quarterly basis if the pool is in use).*
- Lower water levels to below the skimmer lines if needed.
- Drain and winterize (Blow) all lines, filtration, and heating systems. (Certified Pools Antifreezes all lines) Winterizing Duck plugs are an extra charge if you don't have them **(they Are a Must)**
- Add chemicals (shock, algaecide, sequestering agent (Winter conditioner Extra).
- Remove handrails, ladders and put on pool covers.
- Pumps can be removed for winter storage at extra charge (with prior notification & booking)

NOTE: Customers will need to pay attention to their pools and covers during the off season. Pumping your pool down regularly will help keep pool water clean. This is your responsibility. Pools that require a lot of pumping down time in the spring will have additional charges.

- If you want us to monthly monitor your pool and pump it down or re-adjust the cover (re-adjusting cover after first fitting at closing is an additional charge of time/miles) this can be set up. Call for more details and pricing. ***CPLLC is not responsible for any acts of God, to include freeze line breaks, settlement or shifts or any condition caused by weather related issues.**

Winter Services/PPC: Cleaning, Testing & Backwash (For qualified year-round pools South of Nashville only). Contact Certified Pools LLC for special pricing and equipment. Normal cleaning schedule until around December 15th, then it can move to a twice a month service for Jan/Feb/March [if all the parameter/qualifications are correct} EX: Smart Controller, Smart Pump, Freeze Protection, responsible party @ home watching pool/weather.
